Friday aft. lunch

Dear Dad, and Mom;

Got your letter today. I checked the bus schedule a couple days ago (and got the few things I needed). A bus leaves daily at 6:45 AM to Sunbury Pa. (arriving at 8:05 AM) where it leaves at 8:20 A.M. to arrive in Baltimore (Md.) 11:55 AM. There I would get off the Greyhound bus and go to the Trailways terminal. Leaving at 1:15 PM and arriving in Westminster Md 2:05 PM.

I didn't even think of asking the price of a ticket while I was there (as when I got back and told Dave that I had been the the bus station and all, he asked me how much it would cost). I'm fairly sure that it couldn't be much more than \$20. if even that much which doesn't seem likely anyway (for it to be \$20.). I have more than that in my possession (almost \$30 in fact). [I remember that the ticket from Norfolk to Baltimore only cost around 22-24 dollars.]

I will let you know if I go below \$20. in the time from now until I'm sure of a way home.

If I was to take the bus I would have to wait until Wednesday morning because of my one and only class on Tuesday and chapel and work.
