I got your letter today, Dad. Sept. 19, 1970

Saturday

Dear Mom and Dad,

Here goes again. It almost seems monotonous, but it isn't. I enjoy it. I was busy this morning (and afternoon) mowing grass and such things. We loaded the logs by Forest Hall onto a truck and they were taken to a dump. We also cleared crab grass and other weeds out from around the bushes around the Academic Center.

I just did a small wash (my underwear and a pair of socks). I was thinking of doing a big wash today, but I didn't need to so to solve my problem I washed what I would be needing in the sink in the bathroom.

We've been eating fairly good meals still, lately--with a choice yet. The evening meals from Mon. through Thurs. the tables are set and have a table cloth on them. Some employed college guys show you to a table (to fill them up) and set the stuff off the tray onto the
